Police Watch – Brandon Hoelzel and North Everett Officers

Crimes of opportunity. Lock windows/doors, lock your car, and set your home alarms at night. These preventions can detour burglaries and thefts.

License plates are the best evidence

Package thefts –if you are not at home, ask neighbor to look for your package,

Police will go talk to people who are “hanging out” in the neighborhood.

All Everett parks close at dusk

Ring video is effective in catching thieves.

Everett Police currently have open positions available.

Police must witness traffic violations (racing, loud engines) in order to give citations.

Individuals that need to be incarcerated and if Snohomish county jail can't take them they will be taken to SCORE a jail south of Seattle

Car fire at Arboretum – open investigation

Residents are urged to continue to call the police for all suspicious behavior or human safety. EPD will come out and make contact with the person/issue in question

Ability to care for children more quickly than the hospital in Seattle

The new clinic will service about 26K children this year.

No child is refused.

Ages Birth- 21 years old

Not a primary care clinic this is a specialty care clinic. There are 20 specialty care doctors available.

Playroom for childcare while seeing the doctor, rehab room.

Clinic Mon-Friday 7am-5pm

Urgent Care Mon-Fri 5pm-10:30pm

Weekends/Holiday 11am-8pm
