

How to Report Graffiti

- ▶ Report graffiti by calling the Graffiti Hotline at 425-257-8748 or call the Code Enforcement unit at 425-257-8560 or submit an online complaint form at codeenforcement@everettwa.gov.
- ▶ City of Everett ordinances make graffiti removal the responsibility of property owners. However, the City offers a graffiti removal program to residential property owners for abatement of graffiti.
- ▶ Residential properties hit by graffiti may be eligible to participate in the Graffiti Removal Program which provides assistance to property owners by removing graffiti at no cost. To be eligible for the program, graffiti must be publicly visible.
- ▶ A graffiti removal consent form must be submitted to the code unit prior to participation in the Graffiti Removal Program for residential properties.
- ▶ Graffiti Removal Consent forms can be completed online at codeenforcement@everettwa.gov.

Who do I contact about disabled or unlicensed vehicles?

If the vehicle is on private property, contact the city's Code Enforcement Unit at 425-257-8560; if the vehicle is on the street or in right-of-way, contact Parking Enforcement at 425-257-8437 for streets north of 41st Street or 425-257-7505 for streets south of 41st Street, as they can tag it for towing away.

Who do I contact if I have an animal complaint?

Contact Everett Animal Control at 425-257-6000 for suspicion of animal abuse, animal hoarding, noisy animals, animal feces, or questions regarding what animals are allowed to be kept within the City limits.

Who do I contact if construction noise is occurring outside of normal business hours?

The City has established regulations for control of noise in residentially zoned property. Under the City's Noise Ordinance construction related noise is limited to the hours of 7 a.m. to 10 p.m. on weekdays and 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. on weekends and state recognized holidays. Complaints about noise outside of normal construction hours should be directed to Everett Police by dialing 911. Complaints may also be filed during working hours with the Public Works Safety Division at 425-257-8775.

How many garage sales can a person have?

The City of Everett code allows for no more than two sale events for any residence per year and the duration of each event shall be no more than three consecutive days. Signs should be placed on private property and not create a safety hazard for pedestrian or vehicular traffic. They can be displayed three days prior to the sale event and should be removed within 24 hours after the sale. Garage sale items not sold should be removed from the yards and properly stored.

Who do I contact if my landlord won't make repairs to my unit?

Contact the Dispute Resolution Center of Snohomish County at 425-339-1335 for information on what your rights are as a tenant and what the responsibilities are of a landlord.

Who do I contact for zoning information in my neighborhood?

The City Planning Department can answer questions regarding correct fence heights, legal signs and placement, setback standards and land alterations involving protected wetlands, streams, slopes and buffers. For questions contact 425-257-8731.

Is it legal for people to live in motor homes or trailers on private property?

It is prohibited for anyone to occupy a motor home or trailer, beyond 48 hours, outside of an established motor home park within the City limits of Everett.

Tools of a citizen

If you are seeking relief from conditions on a property in your community, there are a number of options available to you:

- ▶ **Make contact with the responsible person.** Describe your perception of the problem. Discuss how the problem affects you and possible solutions.
- ▶ **Attend your Neighborhood Association Meetings;** get involved with solving the problems. For information contact the City of Everett Office of Neighborhoods at 425-257-8717.
- ▶ **File a complaint with Code Enforcement online at codeenforcement@everettwa.gov or at 425-257-8560.** A Code Enforcement Officer will be assigned to investigate the allegations.
